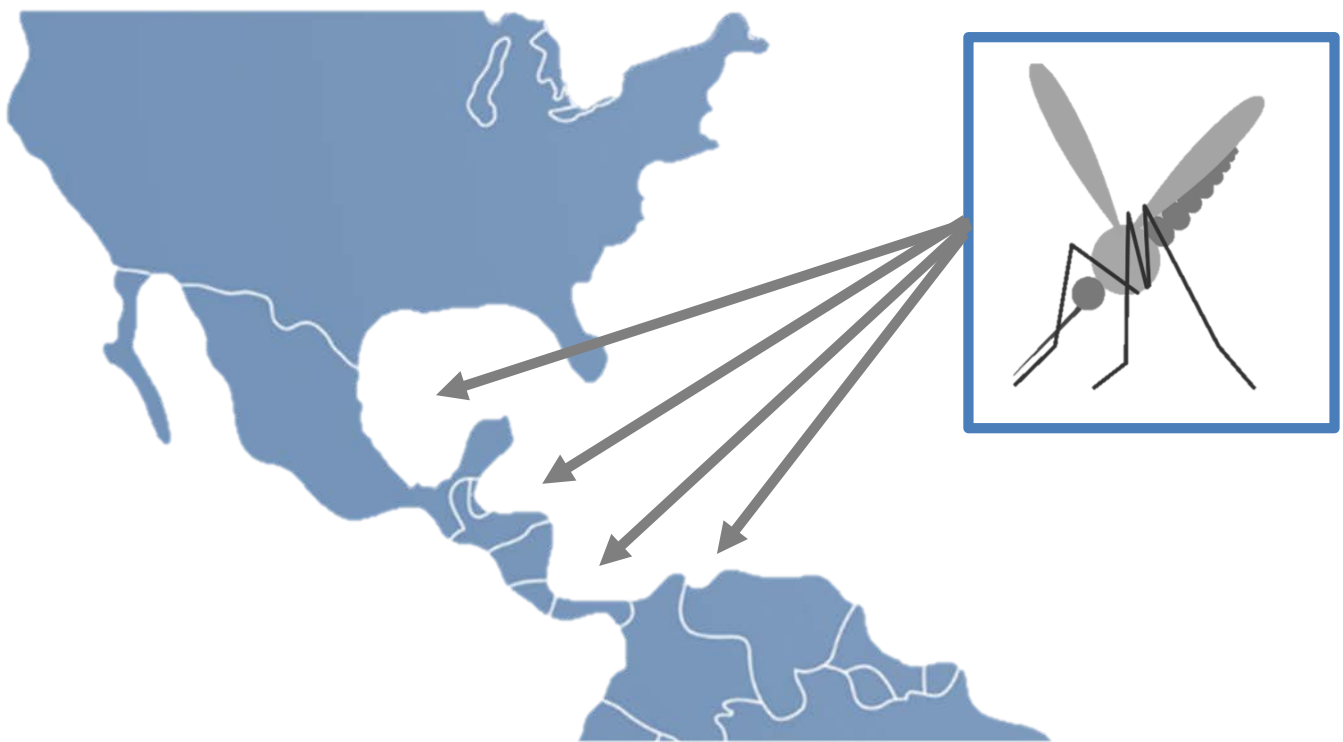





Have you been to Mexico, Central or South America lately?
