## West Nile Virus Was Found in Your Area!

West Nile virus is spread by the bites of infected mosquitoes. Everyone is at risk for West Nile virus. People over age 50 and those with health problems are at greater risk of serious illness, even death.



### Avoid mosquito bites to prevent West Nile virus



Use Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) registered mosquito spray, wipes, or lotion when outside.



Keep mosquitoes out of your home. Maintain your door and window screens in good condition.



Mosquitoes breed in standing water. Prevent mosquito breeding by:

- ✓ Checking items that hold water
- ✓ Covering storage containers
- ✓ Clearing standing water
- ✓ Cleaning vases and pet
- ✓ Casting out old items
