Dear Colleague:

We are pleased to release the *2011 Sexually Transmitted Disease Clinic Morbidity Report* for Los Angeles County (LAC). This report summarizes chlamydia, gonorrhea, syphilis, HIV, and herpes testing in the twelve Sexually Transmitted Disease (STD) clinics operated by the LAC Department of Public Health. The report is organized with an aggregate summary of testing in all clinics followed by sections on individual health centers.


The following are data highlights associated with this report:

- In 2011, there were 40,067 visits at the twelve STD clinics in LAC – slightly more than 60% of which were new visits, and slightly less than 40% were return visits. Among all visits to the STD clinics, men who have sex with women accounted for a majority of visits (49%), followed by women who have sex men (30%), men who have sex with men and women (13%), and women who have sex with women and men (2%). (Table 1.1)
- As a result of the 40,067 visits to the STD clinics in LAC, 25,729 patients tested for STDs such as chlamydia, gonorrhea, syphilis and/or HIV. Chlamydia was the most commonly diagnosed STD (10.3%) among all patients, followed by gonorrhea (4.5%), HIV (0.6%), and early syphilis (0.5%). (Table 1.2)
- Among males visiting public STD clinics in LAC, the highest rates of chlamydia and gonorrhea were found among 15 to 19 year olds, the highest rate of early syphilis was found among 25 to 29 year olds, and the highest rate of HIV was found among 35 to 44 year olds. Among females visiting the STD clinics in LAC, the highest rates of chlamydia and gonorrhea were found among adolescents under 15 years old, and the highest rates of early syphilis and HIV were found among 45 to 54 year olds. (Table 1.4)
- Among males visiting public STD clinics in LAC, African Americans had the highest rate of chlamydia, and Native Americans had the highest rates of gonorrhea, early syphilis, and HIV. Among females visiting the STD clinics in LAC, African Americans had the highest rate of gonorrhea, and Latinos had the highest rates of chlamydia, early syphilis, and HIV. (Table 1.5)
- In 2011, a total of 24,678 chlamydia tests were performed at public STD clinics, yielding 2,535 (10.3%) positive results (Table 1.3). Rates of chlamydia decreased from 12.6% in 2007 to 11.3% in 2008, and held in 2009 before a steady decline to 10.3% (Figure 1.11a).
- In 2011, a total of 24,751 gonorrhea tests were performed at public STD clinics, yielding 1,106 (4.5%) positive results (Table 1.3). Rates of gonorrhea decreased from 6% in 2007 to 4.6% in 2008, and since then have remained stable (Figure 1.11a).

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- In 2011, a total of 22,872 syphilis tests were performed at public STD clinics, yielding 124 (0.5%) positive results (Table 1.3). In the five years leading up to 2011, rates of early syphilis remained low, between the 0.4% and 0.7% range (Figure 1.11b).
- In 2011, a total of 21,063 HIV tests were performed at public STD clinics, yielding 128 (0.6%) positive results (Table 1.3). In the five years leading up to 2011, rates of HIV remained low, between the 0.6% and 0.8% range (Figure 1.11b).
- Among the 128 HIV-positive testers, 23 had both chlamydia and HIV co-infection, 22 had both gonorrhea and HIV co-infection and 11 had both early syphilis and HIV co-infection, suggesting that nearly 44% of all HIV-positive testers were co-infected with an STD. (Table 1.6)

We hope that this report serves as a resource to better understand STD morbidity in our public clinics, and serves as a guide to focus critical STD and HIV casefinding efforts throughout Los Angeles County.

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

Los Angeles County, 2011**





 All Health Centers







Figure 1.5. Reported Chlamydia Cases Among Males in Los Angeles County STD Clinics, by Age Group and Race/Ethnicity, 2011





Figure 1.6. Reported Chlamydia Cases Among Females in Los Angeles County STD Clinics, by Age Group and Race/Ethnicity, 2011





Figure 1.7. Reported Gonorrhea Cases Among Males in Los Angeles County STD Clinics, by Age Group and Race/Ethnicity, 2011





Figure 1.8. Reported Gonorrhea Cases Among Females in Los Angeles County STD Clinics, by Age Group and Race/Ethnicity, 2011






Figure 1.10. Reported HIV cases Among Males in Los Angeles County STD Clinics, by Age Group and Race/Ethnicity, 2011






**Figure 1.11a. Sexually Transmitted Disease Positivity Rates,

2007-2011 All Health Centers (HC)**




**Figure 1.12. Chlamydia Positivity Rates by Gender/Gender of Sex Partners,
2007-2011 All Health Centers (HC)**





2007-2011 All Health Centers (HC)**





Figure 1.16. Chlamydia Positivity Rates by Health Center, 2007-2011




Figure 1.17. Gonorrhea Positivity Rates by Health Center, 2007-2011






Figure 1.18. Early Syphilis Positivity Rates by Health Center, 2007-2011





Figure 1.19. HIV Positivity Rates by Health Center, 2007-2011





Figure 1.20. Urogenital Chlamydia Positivity Rates by Gender/Gender of Sex Partners, 2007-2011, All Health Centers (HC)





Figure 1.21. Rectal Chlamydia Positivity Rates by Gender/Gender of Sex Partners, 2007-2011, All Health Centers (HC)













APPENDIX A: LABORATORY DIAGNOSTIC TESTS USED FOR THE DIAGNOSIS OF SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED DISEASES IN LAC STD CLINICS IN 2011

All specimens sent from the Los Angeles County STD Clinics for gonorrhea, chlamydia, syphilis, herpes, and HIV were tested at the Department of Public Health, Public Health Laboratory. Cervical cytology specimens were tested by the Laboratory Corporation of America (LabCorp) and Foundation Laboratories.

Testing for *Neisseria gonorrhoeae* and *Chlamydia trachomatis*

Chlamydia trachomatis and *Neisseria gonorrhoeae* were detected from urine, vaginal, and endocervical swabs using a nucleic acid amplification test (NAAT) Aptima Combo 2 Assay (Gen-Probe, Inc., San Diego, CA). This same test technology was validated by the Public Health Laboratory to test for chlamydia and gonorrhea in rectal specimens and gonorrhea in pharyngeal specimens. In this report, urogenital testing refers to any urine, urethral, cervical or vaginal specimens.

Testing for syphilis

Blood was screened for syphilis using the Rapid Plasma Reagin (RPR) test which is a nontreponemal assay. The RPR antigen detects reagin, a nonspecific antibody present in the serum of persons with syphilis. Positive RPR tests were followed by the treponemal, confirmatory Treponema pallidum-particle agglutination (TP-PA) assay. The TP-PA detects *Treponema pallidum* antibodies in the serum as an aid in the diagnosis of syphilis and provides useful epidemiological information.

Testing for HIV

Until March 2008, blood was screened for antibody to HIV-1 using a first generation enzyme-linked immunosorbent assay (ELISA), Vironostika HIV-1 Microelisa System (Organon Teknika). In March 2008 the laboratory changed to use a more sensitive third generation test ADVIA Centaur XP, (Siemens Medical Solutions Diagnostics, East Walpole, MA). This is a chemiluminescent assay for HIV 1&2 plus GpO. Positive sera were confirmed using a Western Blot test (Genetic Systems Bio-Rad Laboratories).

Testing for Herpes

Specimens were collected from genital ulcers and other symptomatic sites and tested for Herpes Simplex Virus using a real time polymerase chain reaction method (PCR) (Real Art HSV ½ Light Cycler, Roche Diagnostics) that has been validated by the Public Health Laboratory for performance.

Cervical Cytology

Cervical cytology was performed using a liquid based Pap test (ThinPrep Pap Test, Hologic, MA). A reflex High-Risk HPV DNA test (Digene Hybrid Capture, Qiagen, MD) was performed if the pap result showed Atypical Squamous Cells of Undetermined Significance (AS-CUS).

APPENDIX B: DATA MANAGEMENT

Data Management Methods

With the exception of Antelope Valley Health Center visits, the Public Health Information System (PHIS) was used to examine all visits classified as “STD Clinical Visits.” The information collected from PHIS included demographic information such as gender, age, and race/ethnicity. Specific visit information such as clinic visited, date of visit, and visit classification (i.e., “New” or “Return” visit) was also obtained from PHIS. The Quadramed System provided the demographic and visit information for Antelope Valley Health Center.

Additional information on gender of sex partners and HIV testing history was obtained from the H2541 Intake Forms. The H2541 Intake Form is interviewer-administered to patients at new visits (see below for “new visit” definition) and collects more extensive demographic, behavioral risks, std history, and treatment information.

Sexual orientation of patients was based on the self-reported gender of sex partners from the H2541 Intake Form, which recorded the gender of sex partner(s) for the following two time frames: past 12 months and past 3 months. All available H2541 Intake Forms for each particular patient dating back to 2006 was used for information on gender of sex partners. If a patient had previously only reported no sex partners or refused to report the gender of sex partners on the H2541 form(s), then the sexual orientation for that patient was listed as “unknown”.

SUNQUEST, the Public Health Laboratory database system was used to obtain laboratory results for chlamydia, gonorrhea, syphilis, and HIV. The laboratory results were merged with the PHIS/Quadramed data using the medical record number and the date of clinic visit/specimen collection. In addition, a definitive syphilis diagnosis for those with a positive confirmatory syphilis test was obtained from STD*CASEWATCH. “New HIV” status for patients testing HIV positive was based on previous HIV testing information from all available SUNQUEST, STD*CASEWATCH, and H2541 Intake Form data. If there was no record of a previous positive HIV test in any of these data archives, then the HIV positive patient was designated as a “new HIV” case. The final dataset contains one record for each patient, per visit to the STD clinic (ie. individual visit). The “individual visit” is the unit of observation used in all tables and figures and referred to as such.

Data Limitations

Possibility of multiple visits: If a patient sought care for the same event at multiple clinics, each visit was captured as a separate visit.

Definition of new visits: In order to account for multiple return visits for the same event, a separate analysis was conducted examining only visits classified as “New Visits.” The Department of Health Services’ “Procedures for Completing the Clinic Data/Patient Encounter Form” (Policy No. 301) specifies that:

- A “New Visit” is one in which a person is seeking service for the first time, or for a new episode, in an established clinic in the facility. Examples include a first time visit to a STD clinic; or a visit for a new episode, if the patient was previously treated adequately.
- A “Return Visit” is one in which a patient has a follow-up visit to a clinic or ancillary service in the facility for further evaluation, treatment, or results.

Clinic sessions: A clinic session is a half-day when the STD clinic is open. The number of sessions held varies by STD clinic from 2 sessions a week to 9 sessions a week.
