### Minutes of January 15, 2019

#### 1. <u>Announcements</u>

The meeting was called to order by Executive Director Eve Sheedy at 12:03 p.m.

#### 2. <u>Update/Comments from Executive Director</u>

Ms. Sheedy reported the following updates:

- The Domestic Violence Council (DVC) website has been updated; a calendar has been created which lists meeting details, additionally, agendas and general meeting minutes are now posted on the website
- Instead of forwarding/emailing multiple messages throughout the day, one daily email will be sent from the DVC account at the end of the day containing compiled announcements

- The Homeless Initiative Conference will be on February 7<sup>th</sup>
- The Commission for Women will host the DV breakfast on February 15th

- Dr. Paul Simon will speak at the February DVC General meeting about the importance of data; titled *Data is Your Friend*
- In March the DVC will meet together with the Los Angeles City Domestic Violence Alliance at LAPD headquarters

- Related to the government shutdown, USCIS is still functioning; judges are only hearing detained cases for now
- Processing of U-Visas is being delayed; may take 7-8 years
- NTA Memo published in June initially exempted U-Visas and VAWAs; however, in November it was made applicable to everyone; impact is unknown but expected to be seen soon
