  - Maria Barahona, Compliance Director at haven Hills is voted to serve as Co-Chair of Shelter Director Committee.
- 4. Obtaining landlord tax identification information for rental assistance
  - Meeting participants discussed the challenges to acquire W-9 from landlords. Information and experiences were shared.
  - Group suggested to build a network or relationship with landlords. Encouraging their participation with gift cards or tours of shelter to gain a better understanding of the program.
  - Reminded agencies that it's important to collect W-9 as financial best practice and the agency is responsible as a subcontractor.
- 5. Matters not on the posted agenda (to be presented and placed on a future agenda)
  - Elizabeth Eastland, Rainbow Services provided an update on the DV Systems of Care plan to document and formalize who survivors access care.
    - She asked for agencies to share their intakes, screeners, feedback regarding the work completed to date and thoughts on standard trainings for hotline workers.
    - Araceli Patino offered to lead a Hotline training for service providers.
