Legislation & Policies

- State State budget finalized on June 26, and signed on June 30, including most but not all trailer bills. The requested prevention funds were not included, maybe because prevention is not a one-time expense, but an ongoing expense. Casey Foundation is interested in hearings on mandated reporting.

- SCA 10/Nov 2022 Ballot Measure there will be a ballot measure on November ballot to enshrine right to abortion into state constitution.

Budget Finalized

Federal – see comments on *Dobbs* below.

Local – BOS voted in favor of investigating funds for DV prevention and infrastructure, but investigation will have to be conducted to see what that means – to be continued.

**Emerging Issues** 

DVC General Meeting Reports – Looking for volunteer(s) to present Policy report at DVC General Meeting

Supreme Court - Dobbs Decision – there have been efforts on the federal level to address the overturning of Roe v. Wade, including the passage by the House of a bill this week, but this bill will not pass through the Senate. Discussed messaging that abortions remain "safe, legal and covered by MediCal" in LCA. Discussion held about resources and events. Roman spoke on Piqui's Law as a survivor-led effort by the National Safe Parent Coalition.
