#### **Definitions:**

DHS Hospital: "DHS hospital" is definted as a Los Angeles County hospital that is operated by the LAC Department of Health Services.

Parity: "Parity" is defined as the number of pregnancies resulting in live births to a woman.

Non-smoker: "Non-smokers" are defined as having not smoked any cigarettes three months before pregnancy and during the first, second and third trimester as indicated in the birth record.

Overweight before pregnancy: "Overweight before pregnancy" is defined as Body Mass Index (BMI) greater than or equal to 25 and less than 30 before pregnancy.

Obese before pregnancy: "Obese before pregnancy" is defined as Body Mass Index (BMI) greater than or equal to 30 before pregnancy.

Low birthweight: "Low birthweight" is defined as an infant weighing less than 2,500 grams at birth.

Preterm live birth: "Preterm live birth" is defined as a live birth occurring at less than 37 weeks of gestation and greater than or equal to 17 weeks.

Infant mortality rate: "Infant mortality rate" is defined as deaths occurring less than 365 days per 1,000 live births.
