**Definitions:**

**DHS Hospital:** "DHS hospital" is defined as a Los Angeles County hospital that is operated by the LAC Department of Health Services.

**Parity:** "Parity" is defined as the number of pregnancies resulting in live births to a woman.

**Non-Smoker:** "Non-Smoker" is defined as having not smoked any cigarettes three months before pregnancy and during the first, second and third trimester as indicated in the birth record.

**Overweight Before Pregnancy:** "Overweight Before Pregnancy" is defined as Body Mass Index (BMI) greater than or equal to 25 and less than 30 before pregnancy.

**Low Birthweight:** "Low Birthweight" is defined as an infant weighing less than 2,500 grams at birth.

**Preterm Live Birth:** "Preterm Live Birth" is defined as a live birth occurring at less than 37 weeks of gestation and greater than or equal to 17 weeks.

**Vaginal - Other:** "Vaginal - Other" includes vaginal-spontaneous after previous C-section, vaginal-forceps, vaginal-forceps after previous C-section, vaginal-vacuum and vaginal after previous C-section.

**Infant Mortality Rate:** "Infant Mortality Rate" is defined as deaths occurring less than 365 days per 1,000 live births.

The analysis excludes non-hospital births, birth centers not listed in the birth record documentation, births in clinics or doctor's offices, births in transit, births in unclassifiable locations, or out-of-state hospital births.

Vaginal - "Other" category under Method of Delivery includes vaginal-spontaneous after previous C-section, vaginal-forceps, vaginal-forceps after previous C-section, vaginal-vacuum and vaginal after previous C-section.
